

## REPORT ON PLVs TRAINING

The Mizoram State Legal Services Authority organized Residential Training of Para Legal Volunteers within Aizawl Judicial District i.e, Aizawl District , Kolasib District, Mamit District, Serchhip District and Champhai District from 23<sup>rd</sup> April – 26<sup>th</sup> April, 2019 at Youth Hostel, Luangmual, Aizawl.

**Day-I** : Registration of the participants starts from the evening of 23<sup>rd</sup> April, 2019 in which 108 Para Legal Volunteers from different Districts registered to attend the training.

**Day-II:** The training started with inauguration session in which Mr. Vanlalenmawia, Member Secretary, Mizoram State Legal Services Authority delivered a keynote address and Dr. Rualkhuma Colney, Principal, Govt. Mizoram Law College delivered a motivational speech.
