

**BRIEF REPORT ON
ONE DAY SEMINAR RELATIONSHIP
BETWEEN EXECUTIVE AND JUDICIARY IN THE STATE**

The Mizoram State Legal Services Authority in collaboration with High Court Legal Services Committee organized One Day Seminar on ***“RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN EXECUTIVE AND JUDICIARY IN THE STATE”*** on 12.07.2019 at Taxation Auditorium.

In this programme Hon’ble Mr. Justice Ujjal Bhuyan graced the programme as Chief Guest and Mr. Lalramzauva, Sr. Advocate and Adviser to the Chief Minister of Mizoram graces the programme as Guest of Honour.
